



## WELCOME TO 50/50 for Hope: The CFC Charity Draw!

Welcome to **The Counselling & Family Centre's Charity Draw – 50/50 for Hope**. It is a great way for you to support us whilst having a bit of a flutter! Here's how it works...

You decide how many £2 tickets you would like for the draw each month.

We will allocate a membership number for each ticket you purchase which enters you into the monthly draw. All participants must be over 16.

The draw will take place on the last week of each month, and the winner will be notified via their personal email address.

Payment to the winner will be made via BACS transfer to the corresponding bank account. The name of the winner will be published on the CFC's website and newsletter.

The prize money will be 50% of the membership fee taken for that month, up to a maximum of  $\pounds$ 1,000. The other 50% of the remaining funds will go towards helping to fund projects at The Counselling & Family Centre (CFC) that will benefit our service users and the community.

### How to sign up to our Charity Draw: 50/50 For Hope

- Lawrence will provide you with CFC's bank account details so that you can set up a monthly standing order for your ticket via your own bank account.
- Your standing order will need to be set up monthly to leave your account on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month. You can pay either:

£2 for one ticket

- £4 for two tickets
- £6 for three tickets
- £8 for four tickets

And so on and so on.....

- Once your standing order is set up, please inform Lawrence who will in turn inform you of your membership number.
- If you would like to stop your membership, you will need to provide CFC with one months' notice, then cancel your own standing order after that month.

#### PURPOSE

bank account and will fund projects at CFC that will benefit our service users and the community.

### RULES

- 1. For each £2 contribution per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one draw number
- 2. A draw will be made on the last week of each month with one winner for the prize. (the draw will be made using the Random Integer Generator at https://www.random.org/integers/)
- 3. The prize will total 50% of the monthly income, limited to a maximum of £1000 per draw.
- 4. Our 50/50 for Hope Charity Draw is a private lottery and is open to all paid staff, volunteers and friends of CFC. Anyone aged 16 or over can join.
- 5. Payments must be made in monthly standing order. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
- 6. Draw numbers will only be valid for the draw if the subscription is up to date.
- 7. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
- 8. The draw shall be made by the CEO or Administrator on the last week of every month.
- 9. The winner will receive a BACS payment within one week of the draw.
- 10. The name and number for each month's winner will be posted on the CFC's website and newsletter.
- 11. The Counselling and Family Centre's Charity Draw: 50/50 for Hope will be run by the Operations Team. In case of any dispute the decision of the CEO is final.
- 12. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
- 13. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into CFC's funds after six months.
