Our counsellors follow the child's pace, interests and communication style. The aim is to help them feel safe, build trust, and strengthen emotional understanding.





What to expect:

Counselling sessions typically involve:

- One-to-one sessions with a qualified counsellor
- A safe, calm and confidential setting
- Creative methods such as drawing, play, storytelling or games (where appropriate)
- Goal-setting and solution-focused conversations
- Regular reviews to track progress

Counselling is tailored to each child's age, needs and preferred way of communicating.

Benefits:

- Children & Young People feel calmer and more settled
- Helps them manage big feelings with more confidence
- Improves social and communication skills
- Builds self-esteem and resilience
- Reduces frustration and emotional overload
- Strengthens relationships with peers and adults
- Helps them feel more ready to learn and take part in school life
- Supports transition from primary to secondary school

Our services can also include:

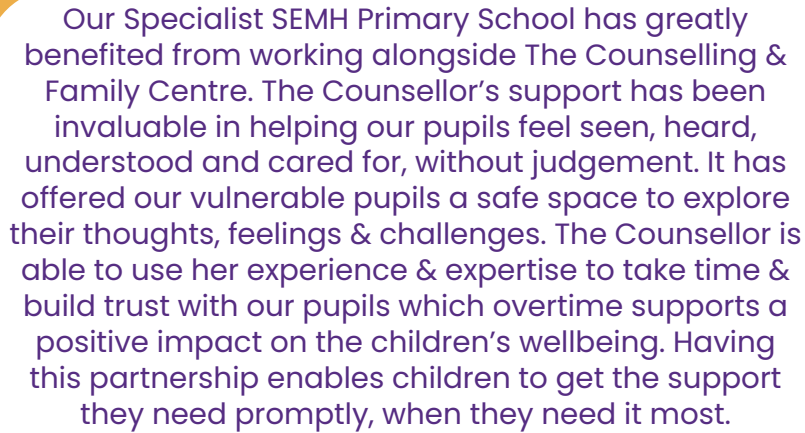
- Small group work on themes such as emotion regulation, worries, anger, building confidence, Support with anxieties connected to transition#

I really enjoyed it and I got talking a lot more, I am now less shy and it was really fun. I will miss it.

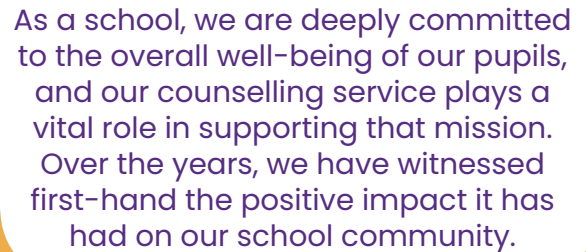
We talk about emotions and how I feel. I enjoyed coming
